Ganta Women’s Vocational Training Center

Pray for the ministry taking place at Nazarene Compassionate Ministries’ Ganta Women’s Vocational Training Center in Liberia. Created some years ago by a local church to encourage women in learning new skills after the ravages of civil war, the center has grown beyond a simple skills training location. In the mornings children attend regular classes until the early afternoon. Then adults learn sewing, tie-dying, soap-making, baking, masonry, and construction. By late afternoon the facility is emptied again, only to fill once more when adult literacy students arrive for evening classes. On Sundays, a worship service takes place in the combined classroom.
